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Dear Friend of Music4Life,

What a year! Starting on September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017, *Music4Life* delivered 277 ready-to-play musical instruments for use by students in Seattle and its surrounding areas. Our independent third-party experts valued these instruments at \$169,000. This compares with 143 instruments delivered the prior year, meaning we nearly doubled our productivity in one year!

When asked how this could happen, we cite: 1) Addition of the Everett Program in November 2016 that collected 87 instruments during the course of the year; 2) Support from Encore Media Group to provide free advertising space in major arts publications; and 3) Streamlining of internal administrative processes.

We are also often asked, how are you going to improve on last year's record? Recently, we announced the addition of two new school district-based *Music4Life* programs serving students attending Northshore and Bremerton Public Schools. Other new programs are being considered. *Music4Life* will continue working very hard to put playable musical instruments into the hands of students who need them. Even though we don't view this as a race, we are mindful that students who can participate in school instrumental music activities tend to benefit academically. Our ambition is to help them all.

Still, we want to celebrate our 2016-17 successes and report them to you in this Annual Report. Many thanks to our instrument and financial donors who provide the resources we need to get the instruments repaired and ready-to-play.

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Purpose

The core purpose of *Music4Life* is to provide ready-to-play musical instruments to participating school districts for use by students in need.

Participating Public School Districts

During the past year (2016-17), Music4Life has had active programs serving students in Edmonds, Everett, Highline, Mukilteo, Seattle and Shoreline Public Schools. The Everett program was added last November and has been an enormous success. A program serving Northshore Public Schools was announced in August 2017. A new program based on support by the Bremerton Central Lions Club is serving the students of Bremerton Public Schools. If successful, it may expand to serve other schools on the Kitsap Peninsula. We have met with and are considering programs for at least three other public

school districts.

Other Collaborating Organizations

Music4Life has been looking for opportunities to collaborate with other organizations serving the instrumental music needs of public school students. At the moment, we are working with two excellent organizations that are addingvalue to students.

Music4Life has been providing "recorders" (the little flute-like instrument that sticks straight out of the mouth) to third and fourth graders in a cooperative program with the **Seattle Symphony**Orchestra called "Link Up." The students get their recorders in late fall, practice on them for a couple months and are then invited in to Benaroya Hall to play their recorders with the Seattle Symphony! A memory to last a lifetime!

This year *Music4Life* formed a collaboration with **Seattle Music Partners**, a non-profit dedicated to bringing more music-learning opportunities to students in low-income schools. The organization does this by offering free after-school and evening programs that use music and mentorship to empower young people. The after-school program works with more than 100 4th and 5th graders, twice weekly, from Leschi, Lowell, and Bailey Gatzert Elementary Schools, as well as Madrona K-8.




Instrument Repairs and Purchases

As an independent non-profit organization, Music4Life has enjoyed the ongoing support of local musical instrument retailers and repair shops. We pay them for the work they do, but at discounted rates that emphasize getting more instruments into the hands of more young students as an enlightened long-term business practice. Vendorpartners are Kennelly Keys Music, Hammond Ashley Violins, Ted Brown Music, Rafael Carrabba Violins, Donn Bennett Drums, Emerald City Guitars, the Guitar Center stores in Seattle and Tukwila and Henselyn Music in Ballard. Abundant encouragement also comes to us from Olsen Violins and Bischofberger Violins. Many thanks to all!

Average Cost of Instrument Repairs

On-average, it costs *Music4Life* about \$125 to repair a used musical instrument. It actually can range from \$50 to \$1,500, depending on the kind of instrument and its value. Because we provide "ready-toplay" musical instruments to public school districts, it is imperative that these repairs are done well. That is the reason we use the skilled technicians listed above. Our instruments may not always be "pretty," but they are playable and are in presentable cases. These are hard costs to Music4Life, just one of the reasons for our ongoing fund raising activities. Instrument repairs consume approximately 85 per cent of our budget.



2016-2017 Accomplishments

The mission of *Music4Life* is to do one thing: Put ready-to-play musical instruments into the hands of students who need them. Besides the growth from the previous year (277 ready-to-play instruments delivered compared to 143 during 2015-16), *Music4Life* also added new programs serving public school students in Everett, Northshore and Bremerton.

There is a tendency to think
this means that 277 more students
will benefit. But if each instrument has a remaining useful life
of three to 15 years (perhaps
more for the new instruments
we buy), anywhere from
three to five students will
use them. This means that
we likely impact over 1,000
students from your contributions in 2017.
